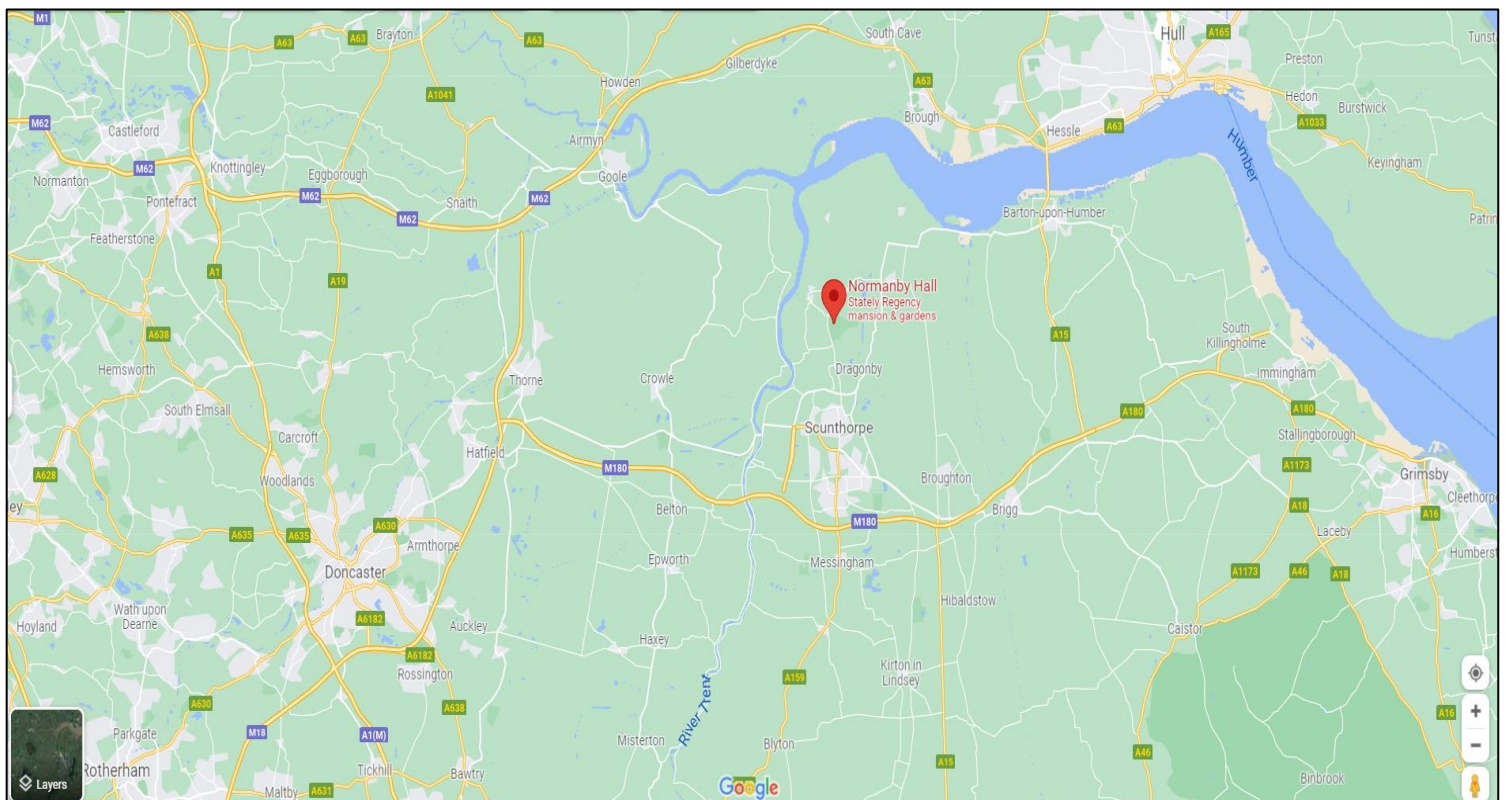
PSUK National Cross Country Champs 2022 Normanby Hall, Scunthorpe Wednesday 16th March 2022

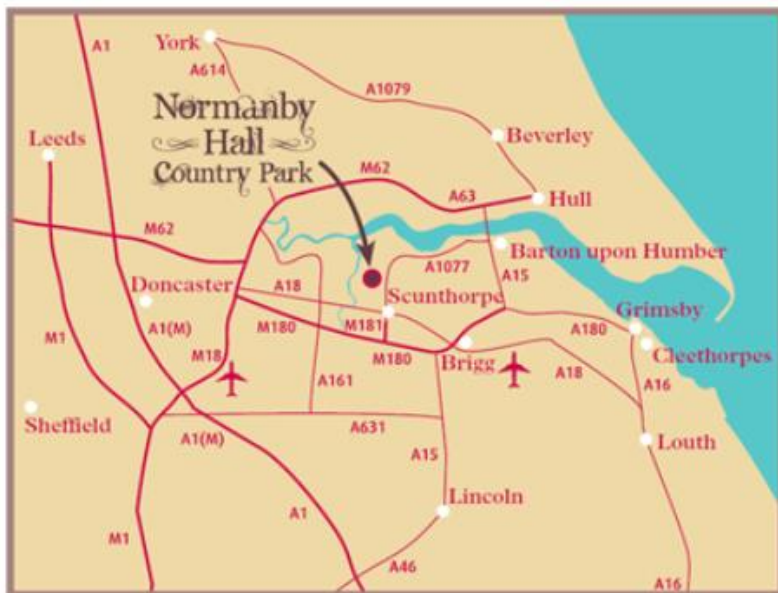
There will be no pre-race registration collections for this event. Team managers (or their representatives) are asked to collect their team packs on arrival at the race venue between 10.00hrs and 12.00hrs.

We will not be able to provide any connecting transport to accommodations in and around Normanby Hall, or ongoing transport to and from the function venue on the

night, so we suggest that teams seek accommodation at either the function venue if possible or nearby in Scunthorpe and the surrounding area. Local taxi companies will also be on hand should you require them.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants and guests are asked to arrange their own accommodation for their attendance at this event. There are rooms available at the function venue for booking on first come first served basis. Please contact the venue direct. There are also plenty of hotels, guesthouses and B&B's in the Scunthorpe area and near to the race location.

PRE –RACE FACILITIES

The race HQ is at Normanby Hall so there will be a changing area, baggage drop and an on site café serving hot and cold food & drink. Unfortunately there are no shower facilities available.

There are limited toilets at the venue (main car park & café), so we do ask runners to be sensible and use them at the earliest opportunity and in good time to prevent any queues forming before the race.

Free parking is at Normanby Hall as directed by an on site marshall.

Litter

It goes without saying that Normanby Hall must be kept tidy and free of litter at all times.

We ask runners on course to please dispose of drinks cups / race gel wrappers sensibly near to any designated water stations and standing marshals who will assist in collecting any discarded items.

RACE


The event will be a 'no spikes' event at the request of our hosts Normanby Hall.


